## Analysis of Parents' Questionnaire- Spring 2017

*The attached graph shows the analysis of the parental responses following the most recent questionnaire (January 2017). 52% of replies were received.*

*It was a wonderful to receive very positive and supportive responses from the majority of parents of pupils of Ysgol y Dderwen. You will notice that a high percentage of parents are very satisfied and happy with the school.*

*The majority of parents strongly agree that their children are making good progress and a high percentage of parents either strongly agree or agree on every aspect within the survey. Thank you very much for your willingness to respond with ideas and suggestions. We will use the evaluations to further develop the school's procedures.*

*The majority of you feel comfortable in approaching the school with questions, suggestions or concerns and you feel that your child enjoys being at school. It was pleasing to read that parents felt that there is a good range of activities including trips and visits and that the school helps your child to become more mature and independent.*

*A small percentage of parents noted uncertainty regarding additional support in relation to any particular needs. In brief, if your child requires any additional support we will contact you in order to discuss your child's requirements in order for us to agree on the way forward. We pride in our open door approach in order for you to contact us if you have any concerns. A minority of parents noted their uncertainty regarding the school's complaints procedure. In brief, if you have a complaint, contact the class teacher in the first instance. You can also contact the headteacher or assistant headteachers if you wish to do so. A copy of the school's complaints policy can be found on the school's website.*

*In addition to collecting the views of parents, the school has undertaken a questionnaire with pupils. All pupils feel that teachers and support staff help them with their learning in order to make progress. 100% of pupils feel safe in school and nearly all state that the school deals well with any issues of bullying. 95% of pupils feel that they are doing well at school and understand what to do and whom to speak to if they find work difficult.*

*These results are very reassuring and confirm the excellent provision and outstanding links between the home and school. Remember that the school has an open-door policy. If you have any concerns regarding your child's education at any time, please contact us immediately.*
